Forecast Challenges

- → Multiple rounds of thunderstorms are expected today through Tuesday.
- → Flash flooding caused by excessive rainfall is possible from this evening through Tuesday evening for portions of our area.
- → Today/Tonight: strong to severe storms are possible, especially along and south of Interstate 70. Greatest potential for severe weather is from 5PM to 2AM.
 - The main threat for severe weather is large hail and damaging winds. Isolated tornadoes are possible.
 - Heavy rain is also possible. Areas that receive repeated rounds of rain will have the potential for flooding. Flash flood threat continues into the Tuesday morning commute.
- → Tuesday: strong to severe storms are likely.
 Greatest potential for severe weather is from 3PM to 10PM.
 - ◆ The main threat for severe weather is large hail and damaging winds. Several tornadoes, some strong or intense, will be possible.
 - Heavy rain is also possible. Areas that receive repeated rounds of rain will have the potential for flooding.
- Overall forecast confidence is medium.

| Damaging Winds | Elevated | Scattered downed trees and powerlines. | Greatest threat along and south of I-70. Tues: Entire Area | Monday 5PM-2AM. Tuesday 3PM-8PM. | Medium confidence |
| Tornadoes | Limited | Isolated tornadoes possible with damage to structures, trees, and powerlines. | Greatest threat along and south of I-70. | Monday 5PM-2AM. | Low confidence |
| Large Hail | Elevated | A few storms may produce hail large enough to cause minor damage to outdoor objects. | Greatest threat along and south of I-70. Tues: Entire area | Monday 5PM-2AM. Tuesday 3PM-8PM. | Medium confidence |
| Areal Flash/Flooding | Elevated | Scattered areas of flooding, mainly localized. Isolated significant flash floods possible. | Along and south of I-70 | Monday into Tuesday. | Medium confidence |
| Tornadoes | Significant | Tornadoes possible with damage to structures, trees, and powerlines. Isolated strong to violent tornadoes possible which could cause significant damage. | Tues: Entire area | Tuesday 3PM-10PM. | Medium confidence |





Flood Watch from Monday afternoon through Tuesday evening








Excessive Rainfall Outlook

For Monday and Monday Night






Severe Weather Outlook - Tuesday





Tornado Outlook - Tuesday








Severe Weather Timing - Tuesday


This graphic is designed to highlight the arrival time for thunderstorms which are expected to pose a significant hazardous threat. Severe thunderstorms are possible outside of these times.
